This **Website User Manual** was developed to provide the SMGA's members with a document that could be easily searched and viewed for instructions on how to navigate the various sections of the SMGAHHI.COM website.

For information associated the Golf Genius – TM Event Portals, please see the **TM Online User's Manual**, a separate document that is also available from the SMGA Website.

Throughout this document, the Golf Genius-Tournament Management system will be referred to as "**TM**". This system was developed by Golf Genius. Some of the SMGA Member clubs use the term "**Golf Genius**" to refer to the system rather than **TM**. Either term can be used as they are the same system.

The SMGA Website “Home Page” is where all actions begin and where the user is returned to when they use the “HOME PAGE” link (in a golf ball) that appears on some of the other pages of the website.

The page has an active “banner” at the top with a moving message about current activities (red text on yellow background), and a second banner with a message at the bottom. Info about joining SMGA is at the yellow star link at the lower left. Local weather information can be obtained by the links at the left and right of the bottom banner message. The “Manuals and Tutorials” link at the bottom provide access to the User Manuals and EC Tutorials (see section below).

The row of green “tabs” below the top banner provide access to different sections of the SMGA website. Each tab will be further explained in separate sections of this document.

All actions associated with Golf Genius – TM are done through clicking on the “Event Sign Up & Payment” Golf Ball at the lower center of the page. The actions that can be performed on the TM “Event Portals” (their term for their web pages) are explained in a separate document – the “*TM Online User Manual*”.

The “Event Information” tab has six options as follows:

- Events Remaining – A listing of the events still to be played with the option to view the complete schedule (see the separate section below).
- Pairings and Tee Times – Once pairings have been created, they will appear here along with a listing of Alternates, if any (see the separate section below).
- Recent Results – A option to view the detailed results of the last event as well as a summary of year to date results (see the separate section below).
- Credits – A listing of the current Frequent Player Tournament “Points” for each member (see the separate section below).
- Announcements – A page to display announcements that are too long for the “banner”.
- Hole by Hole App Tutorial – A link to a YouTube video with a tutorial on using the TM mobile app to enter hole-by-hole scores during an event for a playing group.

The columns shown on the Event Schedule include:

- No. – The event number. This column will also show if the event will provide more than the standard 1 FPT points for those approved for play.
- Date – The date the event will be played.
- Course – The venue of the event. This column will also show if the event is a Trophy Event.
- Event – The format used for this event.
- Days – The number of days of play for the event.
- Section – The SMGA Sections that are eligible for the event.
- Start Time – The type of start used (Shotgun or Tee Times) and starting time.
- HDCP % - The adjustment percentage of the player's Course Handicap used in the event.
- # Players – The maximum number of players allowed in the event.
- Entry Dates – The date range of the open registration period for the event.
- Event Chairmen – The names of the BOG members who will be the Event Chairmen (EC).
- Telephone Number – the phone # of the EC. Players must call the EC if they cannot play.
- View Course – A link to the venue's website (if available)

When the user selects the “Pairings and Tee Times” link, the display provided is a “dynamic frame” to the current information that exists in TM. The dynamic nature of the information shown means that as changes are made in TM, they will automatically be shown in this frame. **The Event Chairmen (EC) for the event are listed at the top right of the frame. Any changes or questions on the event should be directed to them.**

The display is shown “By Tee Times” and shows the: time; starting hole; player’s name, index, course handicap, tee used, and their SMGA ID #. Clicking on the “By Individual” will result in a display sorted by the player’s name. To search for a specific player, their name (or a portion of it) can be entered in the “Filter Players” box.

If there are “Alternates”, a separate dynamic frame will be displayed that will show those members. These members will be shown in the order that they registered, however, when an alternate is selected to replace a player, the selection from this list may be based on handicap index rather than First Come, First Served.

When the user selects the “Recent Results” link, the display provided is a “dynamic frame” to the current information that exists in TM. The dynamic nature of the information shown means that as changes are made in TM, they will automatically be shown in this frame.

There are three categories of results that can be displayed:

- Player Purse Summary – This listing will show the amount of Pro Shop Credit that the individual players who won a prize received for the event Tournament (this purse summary does not include any CTP prizes).
- 4-Man: Stableford – This listing will show the entire field sorted by Flight and position within the flight of all playing groups. In addition to the position and names of the players, their score and any purse award is shown. The title shown will be the tournament name for that event.
- Closest to Pin – This listing will show the prize awarded for any CTP winner. Some of these prizes could be Pro Shop Credit and others could be golf rounds.

When the user selects the "YTD Results" link, the display is a listing of the summary results from all events completed so far for the current season. The "summary" will only display information on the winners of the various prizes that were awarded for each event including the CTP prizes and flighted players prizes. Any "Hole in One" scored during the event is also shown. For those events where a Trophy is awarded, the Trophy Winner is also displayed.

The listing shows the latest event at the top. By scrolling down on the page, summary results of older events can be viewed.

SMGA FTP Points For 2022



SMGA is changing the term used for the recording of a member's event participation. FPT "Credits" will now be referred to as FPT "Points". This page shows each SMGA member how many FPT Points they have for the 2022 season. A player receives points for each event he plays in. It is sorted by points (high to low) then by name. The points that a member receives for playing in an event can be greater than 1 if it is a Trophy Event or an event where a higher number is used to encourage members to participate in the event. Invitations to Frequent Player Event will be extended based on their point standing at the end of the season.

The SMGA has one event at the end of the season that is an "Invitation Only" event. This event is known as the Frequent Player Tournament (FPT). Invitations to this event will be extended to those members who have accumulated sufficient "credits" during the season to be in the top 15% (+/-) of the players with playing points during the season.

Players in an event during the season will have at least 1 point added to their account for each day of play. For some events, such as Trophy events, more than 1 point may be added. While the normal event has an "Open Registration" period with all members being able to register for the event, the FPT registration period will be restricted to those on the "Invitation List". Individual invitations will be emailed to members who are deemed eligible for the event and will contain a link to the registration portal. The format of the event is Individual Stroke Play, and the event is Flighted with 8 players in a Flight. To avoid confusion, all interactions with any TM portal are covered in a separate document, "**TM Online User's Manual**," which is also available through a link on the SMGA website.

- Event Chair List (.pdf) – A “pdf” form used by the Event Chairman in his discussion with the venue staff to clarify options used for the event.

- Covid-19 Protocols – A short statement that explains the SMGA will follow the protocols of the Host Club where the event is being held.
- Web Use Policies – The Terms and Conditions of Use, Privacy and Security Policy, and Refund Policy of SMGA.
- Board of Governors – A listing of the BOG members including the designation of officers and terms.
- Members List – Link to a TM portal with a listing of the SMGA’s members (see following page for more info).
- Club Representative – A listing of the various clubs associated with the SMGA and the BOG member who is the representative of that club. The Club Rep can be emailed using links on this page.
- Members Handbook – The latest revision of the Member’s Handbook. All members should become familiar with the handbook since information in it will provide answers to most member’s questions.
- Constitution and Bylaws – The governing documents of the SMGA.
- WHS Impact on SMGA Events – Info on the World Handicap System (in use since 1/1/2020).
- Fix Your Browser – Information on actions you can take to ensure webpages are current.



Access to an SMGA member's information is not available to the public on the SMGA Website. When you click on the "Members List," you will be leaving the SMGA website and opening a new browser tab on the secure TM website. To access any information on that "portal" (their name for website "pages"), you will need to "Sign In" to TM.

To avoid confusion, all interactions with any TM portal are covered in a separate document, "*TM Online User's Manual*", which is also available through a link on the SMGA website.

When the user clicks on the “Manuals and Tutorials” link on the Home Page, the display above is opened.

- The two links at the top (#1 & #2) provide the “**SMGA Website User Manual**” (this document) and the “**TM Online User Manual**” to the user. These links are for use by all SMGA members.
- The four links at the bottom (A / B / C & D) will open the tutorials that the Event Chairmen (EC’s) use when working in the TM system at an event. While the tutorials are accessible to all SMGA members through these links, the members who are not assigned as Event Managers for the event (the EC's) will not have the proper access to the TM system to perform any of the processes shown in the tutorials, and the tutorial will not provide any useful information to those members.
